- 3. PH II permanent supportive housing for chronically handicapped homeless with severe mental illness Harbor Homes, Inc.
- 4. PH V permanent supportive affordable housing for homeless individuals and families Harbor Homes, Inc. in collaboration with Marguerite's Place and Keystone Hall
- 5. PH IV permanent supportive affordable housing for homeless individuals and families Harbor Homes, Inc.
- 6. PH VI Permanent supportive housing for chronically homeless with mental illness Harbor Homes, Inc.
- 7. Keystone Hall transitional supportive housing for homeless with substance abuse
- 8. Marguerite's Place transitional supportive housing for homeless women with children
- 9. Southern New Hampshire Services supportive services/outreach to homeless
- 10. Nashua Soup Kitchen & Shelter supportive services/education and job training
