- i. Ending Homelessness committee as a standing committee
  - i. Roles of each committee (definition)
- j. Sharing of committee minutes with general membership
- k. What are the standing committees?
- l. Committee meetings open to all?
  - i. HUD wants open process
  - ii. Above suspicion when they are open
- m. Cleaning up redundancies in Meeting language
- n. Financial activities?
  - i. Method for recording in-kind
    - 1. Important for grant consideration
