Good Afternoon,

For the FY2019 Continuum of Care Competition, the NH-502 Greater Nashua Continuum of Care did not reject or reduce any renewal projects for funding.

The GNCoC did receive 2 applications for the Bonus funding. In an effort to approve both projects, the funding request amount for each project had to be reduced. The GNCoC has voted to accept both the State of NH's HMIS expansion grant as well as the Harbor Homes & Nashua Soup Kitchen Coordinated Entry project.

All project applications submitted were accepted and ranked as indicated in the ranking procedures and scoring provided. Individual project applicants were notified of their scores on September 13, 2019. This information will also be made available on the GNCoC website. Please see attached for additional information.
