It is worth noting that case manager Melissa Johnstone is doing great job in assisting families to become first time homeowners. Great job Melissa!

Tom L. from the Maple St. Shelter reported that things are changing and renovations are getting done.

Bridges shelter is scheduled to reopen in July.

Kristy B. reports that the Front Door Agency has a 2-bedroom apartment available. Must be within income guidelines. Taking single mothers with children age 11 or younger. Norwell Home open house on Sunday the 9th if you are interested.

9-5 NSKS males and females need intake with Juana.

Permanent Supportive Housing- Heather let us know that PSL is currently full. Working on 2 grant renewals. Has a single room shared living building outside of Nashua about one hour away from here. Let Heather know if you know anyone who may be interested or in need. The individual doesn't need to be chronically homeless to live there.

Rapid Re-Housing- At risk homeless Veterans. 2 years now since we ended homelessness among veterans in Nashua!

Outreach- Sue Mead attended a national conference. Will be doing another conference soon. Sue is willing to do outreach to any homeless individuals you may see on the streets.

- Kyle Worth, Executive Director from Nashua Adult Day Health bought a building that will be redone and will become affordable housing in the near future. Location is at 49 Harbor Ave. in Nashua. - Scott W. NH Healthy Families- His role has changed, he now is a housing coordinator and he will be doing Behavioral Health work starting in July.
