For the FY2021 Continuum of Care Competition, the NH-502 Greater Nashua Continuum of Care did not reject or reduce any renewal projects for funding.

The GNCOC did receive 4 applications for the Bonus funding. In an effort to approve 2 projects, the funding request amount for 1 project had to be reduced. The GNCOC has voted to accept both the State of NH's HMIS expansion grant at a reduced amount as well as the Stepping Stones project.

The other 2 applications that were received for the Bonus funding was rejected due to the amount given for the Bonus project funding. The GNCOC has voted to reject both the Harbor Care PH-19 grant as well as the Nashua Soup Kitchen & Shelter Coordinated Entry project.

Individual project applicants were notified of their scores on **October 29th, 2021**. This information will also be made available on the GNCOC website. Please see attached for additional information.
