Presentation today from Kyle Worth, Executive Director from Nashua Adult Day Health, www.nashuaadh.com: Nashua Adult Day Health has many programs that serve individuals who are age 18 and over with disabilities. They also have a program specifically for Latinos. They provide transportation throughout Nashua and some surrounding towns. They accept many different insurances and referrals need to be made by medical providers. Private pay for \$75.00 a day. The facility is located at 32 DWH Nashua NH. Kyle will email the slides to all. He is a member of Cultural Connection and that is how they do their outreach. Currently hiring. Looking for feedback to find out what we need in our community. Will stay behind at the end of the meeting to talk to providers.

Second presentation from Jeannie Gonyer from Saint Joseph's Hospital Mobile Health clinic. The RV has a fully function Dentist. Front room has a medical exam. Middle room provides immunizations right now but it will soon be offering mental health services. They go to different area events to offer their services. They are funded by donations and sponsors. All services are confidential and they cannot collect personal information. Will give a tour of the RV afterwards for those who are interested in seeing it.
