Special Meeting to Review and Adopt Ending Homelessness Plan
June 23, 2004

1. Call to Order: 8:10 am by Chairperson Lisa Christie.
2. All present introduced themselves.
3. Introduction and Discussion of Ending Homelessness Plan: K. Nijhuis presented a brief power-point overview of the history of the need for developing the plan ending with the next steps needed to be taken by the CoC which are to:
 - Vote to Adopt
 - Public Release
 - Individual Organization Good Neighbor Agreements
 - Regular Program Checks
4. Vote to Adopt Plan: D. Lozeau motioned that the vote be divided into two votes; one to adopt the plan without Appendix h entitled “Greater Nashua 10 Year Plan Execution”, and the other to adopt Appendix h. T. Epaphras and B. Mack seconded the motion. Discussion ensued.
 - A. Haettenschwiller stated that the heart of the plan is in Appendix h. It states what is going to be done.
 - M. Auer reminded everyone that adopting the plan did not mean it can’t change and it only says “Expected” outcomes, some not until 2008.
 - D. Lozeau stated that the CoC and its Lead Entity or Executive Committee was not organized enough to be able to follow what is outlined in the table in Appendix h. She felt tasks were given out without consulting the people responsible and getting their buy-in.
 - B. Keating requested we consider adopting the plan as is as a proposed plan to get things moving since so much time has already been spent on developing it.
 - L. Christie called for a vote on the motion after stating that only two people from each agency represented at the meeting be allowed to vote (per by-laws). The motion was defeated.
 - A. Haettenschwiller motioned that we adopt the Plan as presented; M. Moriarity seconded it. More discussion ensued.
 - L. Christie called for a vote on the motion with only the same two representatives from each agency voting. The motion carried with 16 for, 3 against, and 1 abstaining.
5. Super NOFA: M. Auer reminded everyone that there were only 20 days left to finish the Super NOFA. The committee is meeting weekly and everyone will

continue to receive e-mails looking for input. Call M. Auer at Harbor Homes if you have any questions.

6. Other: A. Haettenschwiller stated that we need to get a clear set by-laws set up for the CoC as soon as possible.
7. Next Regular Meeting: July 7, 2004, Room 208, Nashua City Hall at 8:00 am.
8. Adjournment: The meeting adjourned at 9:03 am.
